Common House Fly & Lesser House Fly

These worldwide pests are a major health risk. They are attracted to and breed in decaying animal and vegetable waste, carrying with them a large number of disease organisms such as intestinal worms, dysentery and gastroenteritis.



Bluebottle

One of the principal pests of public health. Blue Bottles, or blow flies, are renowned for landing and feeding on rotten meat and faeces, transferring disease organisms to fresh meat and food intended for human consumption. It is a major cause of food poisoning and disease.



Cockroaches

This major public health pest feeds on human and animal waste and on human foodstuffs. Cockroaches are particularly associated with areas where food is stored or prepared but are also a common pest in hospitals and laboratories where they feed on sputum and other clinical specimens. Cockroaches not only carry and deposit disease-causing bacteria, such as salmonella but there is evidence that they are capable of causing serious allergic reactions, such as asthma.

The presence of flies and cockroaches in food preparation, storage or serving areas presents a risk that food could be rendered unsafe and unsaleable. Stinging or biting insects, such as wasps and ants, can cause distress, shock and even death through severe allergic reaction.
